**2006 q. 11.** A management information system works at a tactical level to produce reports summarising data from data processing systems, allowing managers to plan for the future.

**2007 q. 9.** An Executive Information System allows drill-down in detail to the level below.

**2008 q. 9.** A Decision Support System allows managers at a tactical level (mid-management) to retrieve, summarise and analyse data to help to make decisions.

**2008P q. 11.** Two types of reports produced by a Management Information System could be a summary report, extracting only the key information from a project perhaps, such as total revenue figures.  
Another would be a periodical report, such as an annual report on the progress of a health club in its first year.

**2009 q. 10.** Managers could use an Executive Information System to produce graphical, summarised output from another information system by drilling-down.
